Conference

The past ADRS Conferences have been the largest Double Reed events in Australia.

This year we are presenting the first semi-regional conference in the holiday destination the Gold Coast, Queensland, Australia.

In 2022 ADRS Melbourne Conference attracted over <u>150 participants</u>, the 2018 the ADRS Conference in Melbourne over <u>130 participants</u> and in 2016 the Sydney ADRS Conference had over <u>180 participants</u>. The 2021 ONLINE conference had over 100 entries in the competition.

This 2-day weekend conference will focus on "all things Oboe & Bassoon" with performances, masterclasses, lectures, technical workshops, reed making, exhibitor displays and our annual competition. The venue is situated a stone's throw from Surfers Paradise, famous theme parks, cruises and everything the Gold Coast has to offer.

Competition

The Australasian Double Reed Competition (ADRC) has been running bi-annually for over 20 years. The last live competition in Melbourne in 2022 was a great success, with over 100 entries overall.

High quality artists are a key to a successful conference. In 2024 we are inviting a few key artists whilst focusing on local presenters and double reeders.


A call for the submission of papers for the conference has been made and will close at the end of May 2024. We also encourage all exhibitors to offer Artists or any presentation suggestions for the conference.

Australasian Double Reed Competition 2024

• **Beginner** (up to Grade 2 AMEB) Learning for no more than 2 years

1 work - solo or with piano accompaniment

Time limit: 2 minutes

Junior (Grades 3-4 AMEB) Learning for no more than 4 years

1 work - solo or with piano accompaniment

Time limit: 4 minutes

Intermediate Section (Grades 5-6 AMEB) Learning for no more than 5 years

1 work - solo or with piano accompaniment

Time limit: 5 minutes

Senior Section (Grades 7-8 AMEB) Up to age 18 (1 SET PIECE PLUS OWN CHOICE)

Set work & Own contrasting choice with piano accompaniment.

Time limit: 5 minutes

- Elite Section (Open Age) (Full-time professional players not eligible) (1 SET PIECE PLUS OWN CHOICE) Set work & Own contrasting choice with piano accompaniment (Time limit: 6 minutes)
- Beginner Adult Over 18 Years (up to Grade 5 AMEB)

1 work – solo or with piano accompaniment

Time limit: 5 minutes

Weekend Warrior & "Friends" Section/ Chamber Music

Over 18 Years (full-time professional players not eligible, Secondary Teachers are welcome)

From 1 to 5 players any combination (at least one double reed instrument)

1 work – solo or with any combination of accompaniment/ensemble

Time limit: 10 minutes

Baroque (Open Age) A baroque work performed on period or modern instrument

1 work – solo or with piano accompaniment

Time limit: 5 minutes
